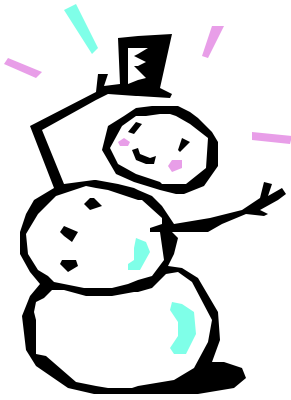

Family Hand-print Cards

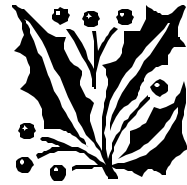
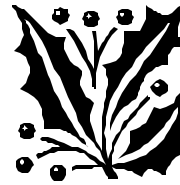
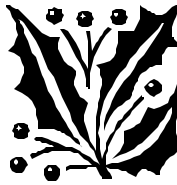
Materials
