IT'S THAT TIME AGAIN! PROJECT JUDGING BOARDS FOR THE FEBRUARY COMMUNITY MEETING... WHAT ARE THEY?

There always seems to be a little confusion about <u>what exactly are</u> "Project Judging Boards"? Basically, they are very simple.

- 1. Your project group will need to get together and come up with a simple theme that represents the project. For instance: The poultry project can choose feed, and what would be the most nutritious feed for a chicken.
- 2. You will need a poster board, pens or paints, and a ruler.
- 3. You will then need to make four sections, or squares, on your board, labeling them A, B, C, and D, one letter in each square.
- 4. Now back to the chicken feed example. You will title your board something like "What is the Best Food for a Chicken."
- 5. In each lettered box draw or paste four examples (whatever your theme is). Example: Bread Crumbs, Bird Seed, Grass, and Chicken Crumble Feed, in random order. On the back of the board you will put the answers in order to the best to the worst. Example: C. Chicken Crumble, B. Bird Seed, A. Bread Crumbs, D. Grass
- 6. During the February Meeting the members will try to figure out the correct order on sheets handed out at the meeting.
