(Each class is limited to 2 Items)

There will be three (3) County Winners recognized.

- Class 2500      BONSAI**      Any attempt to capture the feeling of a tree from nature in a small container. **Must have been created by member at least six weeks before Exhibit Day.**
- Section 1.      Evergreen types
- Section 2.      Flowering/fruiting types
- Section 3.      All other types, i.e., bamboo, maple....
- 
- Class 2600      MAME**
- 
- Class 2700      ORNAMENTAL**
- Section 1.      Flowering plant mimi-garden; seedlings or full grown
- Section 2.      Succulent and or cactus mini-garden
- Section 3.      Dish gardens (must have been cared for by participant for at least six weeks.)
- Section 4.      Terrariums - closed environment, may have lid, high sides. Identify plants used, common and scientific names. Identify soil medium used.
- Section 5.      All other mini-gardens: seedlings or full grown
- Section 6.      Display of learning.

**Rules:**

Exhibitor must be enrolled in project entered.  
All entries are to be checked in between 8:00 a.m - 9:00 a.m.  
Entries may not be removed until the end of the awards ceremony.  
All exhibitors are responsible for area clean-up.  
To avoid confusion, only clerks, and area supervisors are to be present during judging.

**All entries are the responsibility of the 4-H member. Nojoqui 4-H officials will not be held responsible for any damage that might occur during this event.**

**All entries must be POST MARKED by May 1.**

### Bonsai Score Card

Bonsai is an attempt to capture the feeling of a tree from nature in a small container that can be enjoyed in your garden or home. The more interesting trees in nature are usually old and have had to struggle for survival. They may have been wind blown or struck by lightning. These are the types of trees most commonly initiated for bonsai.

General appearance	60%
Condition of plant	20%
Neatness	10%
Suitability of container - should not distract from plant.	10%
